



LABOUR LAW UPDATES

SI 186 of 2024 on the minimum wage is stipulated as follows:

The Government through the Ministry of Public Service, Labour and Social Welfare has gazetted a minimum wage of USD \$150 through SI 186/2024.

Any employer who had paid less than the set minimum wage after the effective date of 22

November 2024 is obliged to settle the outstanding amount witihn 2 months.



According to the latest SI, SI 191 of 2024, the minimum package is stipulated as follows:

Unless better terms are negotiated and agreed between the employer and the employees concerned or their representatives, a minimum retrenchment package of one month's salary or wages for every year of service as an employee or the equivalent, lesser proportion of (one month's salary or wages for a lesser period of service) shall be paid as compensation for loss of employment.

Why Morning Devotions Matter:


